- A Herd Prefix is not limited to a certain number of characters.
- If a Herd Prefix includes multiple words, the prefix must be continuous. Ex: Green\_Hill, ASA/MC
- Names of animals registered at the ASA must not exceed 25 characters including Herd Prefix.
- A Herd Prefix may be used by other family members, or associated herds, provided written consent from the registered owner of the prefix.
- The purpose of using a Herd Prefix is to make your cattle herd identifiable and consistent.
- In cases of the same prefix\*, preference will be given to the member who first used the prefix and/or when the application to register the prefix was first made with the ASA. \* The Second or Third choices will only be used in these cases.
